Schedule

The Championships will comprise three separate events, all of which have been awarded National record status.

Southern Counties AS Individual Championships

Round: Portsmouth

Scoring: inner ten ring scoring on three spot target faces for compounds.

Entry fee: £8.50.

Assembly: 9.15 am.

Sussex CAA Team Championship

Round: 18m FITA

Teams: 4 archers including at least one lady or junior, minimum of 2 recurves.

Target faces: 4 x 40cm faces per butt, inner ten ring scoring for compounds.

Entry fee: £30 per team.

Assembly: 12.30 pm.

Sussex CAA Individual Championships

Round: 18m FITA.

Scoring: inner ten ring scoring on three spot target faces for compounds.

Entry fee: £8.50.

Assembly: 3.45 pm.

Presentation of trophies and medals

Trophies and medals will be presented after shooting has ended (around 7.30 pm).

Regulations and requirements

Eligibility

All three competitions are open to individuals and clubs affiliated to GNAS or a FITA member association. Entries will be accepted on a first received, first entered basis.

Please use the correct entry form(s). Three forms, one for each competition, are attached.

GNAS registration cards

Every entrant should bring their GNAS registration card to the event. Please be ready to produce your card for inspection if this is requested.

Entrants registered with a FITA Member Association other than GNAS should bring proof of their membership to the shoot.

Dress code

The dress regulations described in GNAS rule 307 will apply. Archers must wear plain white, plain dark green or their registered club colours.

Please note that footwear must have soft soles and must not mark or in any other way damage the hall floor.

Drug testing

Any archer asked to provide a sample for drug testing must comply. A refusal will be treated as a positive result.

A parent or guardian must sign a junior's entry form to signify their consent to their child being tested. They should also explain the implications of drug testing to their child.

Photography

In accordance with the provisions of the GNAS Protection of Children and Vulnerable Adults Policy, anyone wishing to take photographs at the event must register with the Tournament Organiser on arrival at the K2. No unauthorised photography will be permitted.

1. Entries

2. Entry Fees

The entry fee is £30 per team. Please enclose a cheque (payable to SCAA) for this amount with your team's entry form.

3. Composition of Teams

Each team shall comprise four archers. This must include a minimum of two recurve archers and at least one lady or one junior archer. Team members must be members of GNAS or another FITA Member Association.

4. Substitutes

If a team member is unable to shoot, a substitute can be named on the day of the competition. Substitutes must provide proof of GNAS or FITA Member Association membership.
